## Here's how the CTE millage proposal will benefit our students and our community...

- ✓ CTE programs will be enhanced and expanded for our students.
- ✓ More students will graduate prepared for high-skill, high-wage jobs and careers.
- ✓ More students with specialized skills will be available to employers in our area.
- ✓ CTE tuition fees for students will be eliminated (freeing up funds for other educational improvements in local school districts).
- ✓ CTE-related instructional equipment will be updated and expanded.
- ✓ C.O.O.R. ISD will continue subsidizing the cost of transporting students to CTE programs operated by C.O.O.R. ISD.
- ✓ More students will be eligible for "early college" credit. This means more students can graduate from high school with an Associate's Degree or certification in their area of study with no tuition costs to students or their parents!
